#### **GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT**

Please review the following guidelines with members of your party so that everyone has a safe and fun stay at our campground.

- Check out time is 11 a.m. Due to previous reservations, if you plan on staying longer, the earlier you re-register, the better your chance of keeping your site. Please communicate clearly with park manager. Site extensions are at the discretion of park management.
- **Speed Limit:** Please observe a speed limit of no more than 7 mph.
- Quiet time 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.; please be considerate of others. No loud music at any time.
- Sewer: Sewer connection a positive sewer seal at both ends of sewer hose is required.
   Texas law requires that a sewer hose must be fastened using a connector or a rubber donut.
- NO FIREWORKS ALLOWED. NO OPEN FIREARMS DISPLAYED.
- Trash: Dumpster located in the park is for personal trash only. All garbage must be bagged & tied, boxes broken down. DO NOT leave trash outside by your RV or outside of the dumpster. Cleanliness of the park is important to us. Sites are to be kept clean and orderly, as determined by management. Please leave laundry room as you would like to find it. If any areas are in need of attention, please notify the manager. Washing vehicles in the park is prohibited, however; keeping your RV clean and in good repair is required.
- Parking: Two vehicles only per RV space if your space is large enough. Please park parallel to your RV out of the main drives. Do not park on medians.

- **NOT ALLOWED:** Clothes Lines, Electric Space Heaters, Cheater Boxes, or Pigtails.
- Conduct: Disorderly conduct, drunkenness, illegal drugs, obscene language, obnoxious, disruptive or vulgar behavior will not be tolerated. They will be cause for immediate removal without refund.
- Internet: Wireless Internet is only for our guests and allowed visitors. Premium wifi is available for a fee.
- Pets: Pets need to be on a leash unless you are in the K9 park. You must clean up after them, and they should never be left unattended. Pets are welcome in designated, pet-friendly Camping Cabins and Deluxe Cabins. NO AGGRESSIVE BREED DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARK.
- Children: We want the children to be safe & have a good time, but always under the watchful eyes of a parent/guardian. Please use good judgement if you decide to leave your children at the park when you are gone. We are not responsible for their safety or welfare. You are liable for their behavior.
